This Privacy Policy explains how SPINDO.TECH ("SPINDO.TECH", "we", "our", or "us") collects, uses, shares, and protects personal information when you visit <https://spindo.tech> (the "Website"), contact us, or discuss our professional services.

1. Who we are

2. Information we collect

Information you provide. When you submit a project enquiry or communicate with us, we may collect:

- Your name and work email;
- Company name;
- The product or service you are looking to build;
- Project description, current platform, constraints, and expected outcome;
- Optional estimated budget and expected start period;
- Optional company website or LinkedIn profile;
- Messages, files, and other information you choose to provide.

Information collected automatically. When you use the Website, we may receive technical data such as IP address, browser and device type, operating system, language, referring page, pages visited, approximate region, timestamps, interaction data, and Website performance information.

Cookies and similar technologies. We use cookies and related technologies for Website operation, security, preference storage, analytics, and—where you consent—advertising measurement. See our Cookie Policy for details.

3. How we use information

- Respond to enquiries and assess whether we can support a project;
- Prepare proposals, estimates, delivery plans, and contracts;
- Provide and manage agreed engineering or consulting services;
- Communicate about projects and maintain business relationships;
- Operate, secure, troubleshoot, and improve the Website;
- Measure Website and campaign performance where consent is required and obtained;
- Prevent abuse, fraud, and unauthorized access;
- Comply with legal obligations and protect our rights.

We do not sell personal information.

4. Legal bases

Where the GDPR, UK GDPR, or similar law applies, we process personal data based on one or more of: your consent; steps taken at your request before entering a contract; performance of a contract; compliance with a legal obligation; and our legitimate interests in operating, securing, and developing our business, provided those interests do not override your rights.

5. Sharing information

We may share information with providers that help us operate the Website and business, including hosting, infrastructure, analytics, security, customer communication, and professional advisory providers. We may also disclose information where required by law, to protect legal rights, or in connection with a corporate transaction. Providers may use information only for the agreed purpose and must protect it appropriately.

6. Analytics and advertising services

Subject to your cookie choices, the Website may use Google Analytics 4, Google Tag Manager, Google Ads, and Google Consent Mode. and meeting legal obligations. Retention periods depend on the type of information, the relationship, and applicable law.

9. Security

We use reasonable technical and organizational measures intended to protect personal information against unauthorized access, loss, misuse, alteration, and disclosure. No method of Internet transmission or storage can be guaranteed completely secure.

10. Your rights

Depending on your location, you may have rights to access, correct, delete, restrict, or object to processing of your personal data; receive a portable copy; withdraw consent; and complain to a supervisory authority.
